Brick Bay Sculpture Trail

The Brick Bay Sculpture Trail showcases contemporary sculpture by established and emerging artists. The Trail winds through a remarkable landscape framed by towering native trees and majestic palms, abundant birdlife, green pastures and vineyard.

The Brick Bay Sculpture Trust operates as a charitable trust, with surplus revenue made available to assist selected artists in meeting the considerable expense of building outdoor works.

Sculptures presented are new works selected by a curatorial panel and all works are for sale. Exhibits change regularly as sold works are replaced.

The track is an easy one-hour walk suitable for most ages and abilities. Surfaces on the trail are grass, bark mulch, pebbles and wooden boardwalks. The trail is undulating terrain that winds through a valley; there are several sets of easily negotiated stairs and viewing benches are located at regular intervals along the trail.

Last trail entry is 4pm.

The sculpture trail has given us much joy in its realisation. We hope you too experience the pleasure we have had along this journey, a journey that is only just beginning.
